

Parks Victoria April 2020 Board Meeting Report

The Parks Victoria Board met for a virtual meeting on Tuesday 28 April to discuss a range of important issues and opportunities. The highlights of the meeting are outlined below.

General

The Board received a comprehensive briefing on changes to current operations and working arrangements. The Board noted park closures, internal governance measures and co-ordination with other government agencies.

Safety

The Board congratulated Management and staff for significant safety improvements. Recent results show a notable downward trend in safety incidents for 2020.

Churchill and Lysterfield Park Management Plan

The Board approved amendments to the Churchill National Park and Lysterfield Park Management Plan. The Plan will be submitted to the Minister for Energy, Environment and Climate Change for approval to release by June 2020. He advised that the plan aims to confidence to the mountain biking community by expressing mountain biking as a key activity, recognising the existing trails, and framing the areas of the parks that may be for further change, such as new trails.
