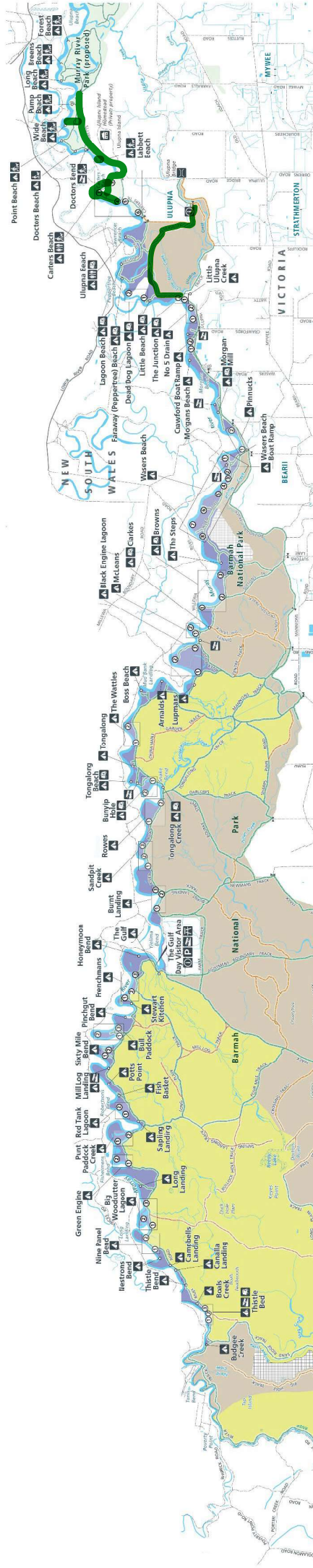
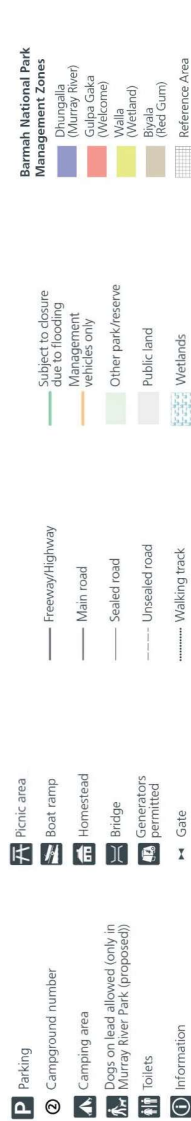

What can I do where?

Camping and fire regulations by management zone.
Green symbols indicate that an activity is permitted within stated restrictions.
Fireplaces are not available in the Biyala zone.

Camping permitted in designated areas please refer to the park maps				
Use of generators permitted only between sunrise and sunset in designated camping area as depicted on the park map				
Fires permitted in fireplaces provided prohibited on days of Total Fire Ban				N/A
Fires permitted in self-dug pits but not within 50m of provided fireplaces. All fires must comply with the regulations below				
Using chainsaws is only permitted in Walla zone ; within 10m of the Gulf Track and in Biyala zone ; within 10m of vehicle tracks open to the public. They are prohibited on Ulupna island
