

# Grampians National Park Access Update

## 1st of August 2020

Grampians National Park may have closures in place from natural events (storms, floods and bushfires), park operations, projects and other circumstances. **Before visiting the park always check for closures on the list below. Please adhere to signs and notifications, and do not enter closed areas.**

### Brambuk the National Park and Cultural Centre

As of the 1st of July 2020, Parks Victoria has temporarily taken on management of Brambuk the National Park and Cultural Centre.

The centre will remain closed while Parks Victoria undertakes due diligence assessing infrastructure, facilities and conducting essential works.

Visitors seeking park information in person are asked to visit the Halls Gap Visitor Information Centre.

### Campgrounds

- Online and phone bookings are open.

### Roads and 4WD Tracks

- VicRoads is currently undertaking road works along Mt Victory. Traffic management is in place and delays are expected. Due to finish on the 14<sup>th</sup> of August 2020.
- Seasonal Roads are now closed until November 2020.

### Walking Tracks

- **Mackenzie River Walk:** Temporarily closed between the base of Mackenzie Falls and the top of Fish Falls due to damage to steel steps. Mackenzie Falls remains open.
- **Grand Canyon:** Steel steps on south-eastern exit of the canyon are closed pending engineering assessment. The Grand Canyon remains open as a return walk from the Wonderland Carpark end. The Pinnacle walk remains open via the canyon bypass walking track.
- **Major Mitchell Plateau Walking Track:** Closed between First Wannon Hiker Camp and Jimmy Creek Campground until mid-2020 due to Grampians Peaks Trail (GPT) works.

First Wannon Hiker Camp remains open and accessible as a return walk from Sheep Hills Carpark, Mt William and/or Kalymna Campground.

- **Stapylton Loop Walk:** The eastern half of the loop is overgrown and indistinct in many places. Not recommended. A new alignment associated with the GPT is due to open in late 2020.
- **Longpoint East Hiker Camp to Boroka Lookout walking track:** Permanently closed due to a new GPT track alignment. Please do not use this walking track, which may still appear on old mapping publications.

### Rock Climbing

### GRAMPIANS PEAKS TRAIL

Grampians Peaks Trail construction works are occurring along the north south alignment. While most walking tracks remain open, bushwalkers may encounter closures in areas away from established walking tracks. If you require detailed advice call 13 1963 prior to your walk.
