Southern Toadlet are Endangered in Victoria, and they need your help! Southern Toadlets breed from March to June and lay their eggs in shallow nests or burrows in low lying areas, such as the tracks in this reserve.

Parks Victoria have temporarily modified parts of the reserves to protect the breeding areas of this species.

How can you help?

- 1) If you think you have seen or heard a Southern Toadlet, upload a picture to iNaturalist
- 2) Plan ahead. Keep to the management vehicle tracks and be aware of seasonal closures
