



Parks Victoria August 2021 Board Meeting Report

The Parks Victoria Board met on Tuesday 31 August 2021 to discuss a range of important issues and opportunities. The highlights of the meeting are outlined below.

People and Parks Foundation Presentation

The People and Parks Foundation provided a presentation to the Board on achievements and priorities for future years.

Chelsea Australian Garden Exhibit

The Board approved the designs and construction of the Chelsea Australian Garden Exhibit at the Dandenong Ranges Botanic Gardens.

Strategic Risk Deep Dives

The Board conducted strategic risk deep dives into Sustainable Built Assets and Governance (Capital Projects), discussing risk rating controls, treatments, and monitoring and reporting.

Annual Report

The Board acknowledged the efforts of Management and staff throughout the 2020-21 financial year and approved the 2020-21 Annual Report, 2020-21 Annual Financial Report and the 2020-21 National Parks Act Report.

Total Recordable Injury Frequency Report (TRIFR)

The July TRIFR was 10.8 which exceeds (i.e. is lower than) the 2021-22 target of 13.5.
