The Board acknowledged and celebrated recent awards received by Parks Victoria	In October 2023, Werribee Park received a Green Flag Award from the International Green Flag Council, recognising Werribee Park's quality green spaces, the hard work of Werribee Park volunteers, managers, team members and local residents, and its outstanding horticulture, heritage, events, and community programs. In November 2023, the Grampians Peaks Trail received the Victorian Tourism Industry Council's Ecotourism Award for delivering a trail experience that provides an inspirational world-class walk showcasing the awe-inspiring beauty of the Grampians, attracts visitors to Victoria and strengthens opportunities for the local regional visitor economy.
