

# Parks Victoria May 2021 Board Meeting Report

The Parks Victoria Board met on Tuesday 25 May 2021 to discuss a range of important issues and opportunities. The highlights of the meeting are outlined below.

### **Total Recordable Injury Frequency Rate (TRIFR)**

The April 2021 Total Recordable Injury Frequency Rate (TRIFR) was 10.9 which exceeds (i.e. is lower than) the 2020-21 target of 14.5.

## **Nature Conservation Strategy**

The Board approved the Nature Conservation Strategy that establishes the strategic directions for Parks Victoria to conserve and protect nature on Victoria's park estate for the next ten years (2021-2031).

#### Fire briefing from the Chief Fire Officer

The Board received a comprehensive briefing from the Chief Fire Officer, Department of Environment, Land Water and Planning and had a productive discussion about the planned burn program and environmental / ecological issues.

### Update on the proposed Warburton Shire Council mountain bike project

The Board received a briefing from the Yarra Ranges Shire Council on the project status and Environmental Effects Statement (EES) required under the *Environmental Effects Act 1978* for the proposed Warburton Mountain Bike Trail.

#### **Capital program**

The Board received a briefing on the capital program and a comprehensive report on the key risks.
