



Parks Victoria December 2019 Board Meeting Report

The Parks Victoria Board met on Tuesday 17 December to discuss a range of important issues and opportunities. The highlights of the meeting are outlined below.

Grampians Landscape Management Plan

The Board received a progress report on the Plan, which has recently completed the first stage of community consultation. The Plan will underpin the strategic planning for the Grampians landscape for the next 15 years.

Land Management Strategy

The Board received a progress report on the Land Management Strategy, which will set the future direction for Parks Victoria's management of the parks estate.

Open Safe and Clean Pilot Program

The Board is pleased to have endorsed a pilot of this program, which provides a tool to measure how well the organisation is tracking in maintaining core visitor experience standards across the parks estate.

Membership Pilot Program

The Board approved a pilot program, to invite members of the public to actively engage with Parks Victoria in learning about, protecting and being in nature.

Fire Outlook

The Board received an update from the Chief Executive Officer on the fire situation in the Gippsland region.

Sustainability Initiatives

The Board approved several sustainability initiatives for the organisation, which will be announced shortly.
