

FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Selective hazardous tree treatment and vegetation mulching will take place in Kinglake National Park to reduce bushfire risk and improve fire and emergency access.

Date: Mid-January 2023

Duration: Approximately 3 weeks (weekdays only)

Location: Road 47, near Whittlesea-Yea Road, Humevale (see map)

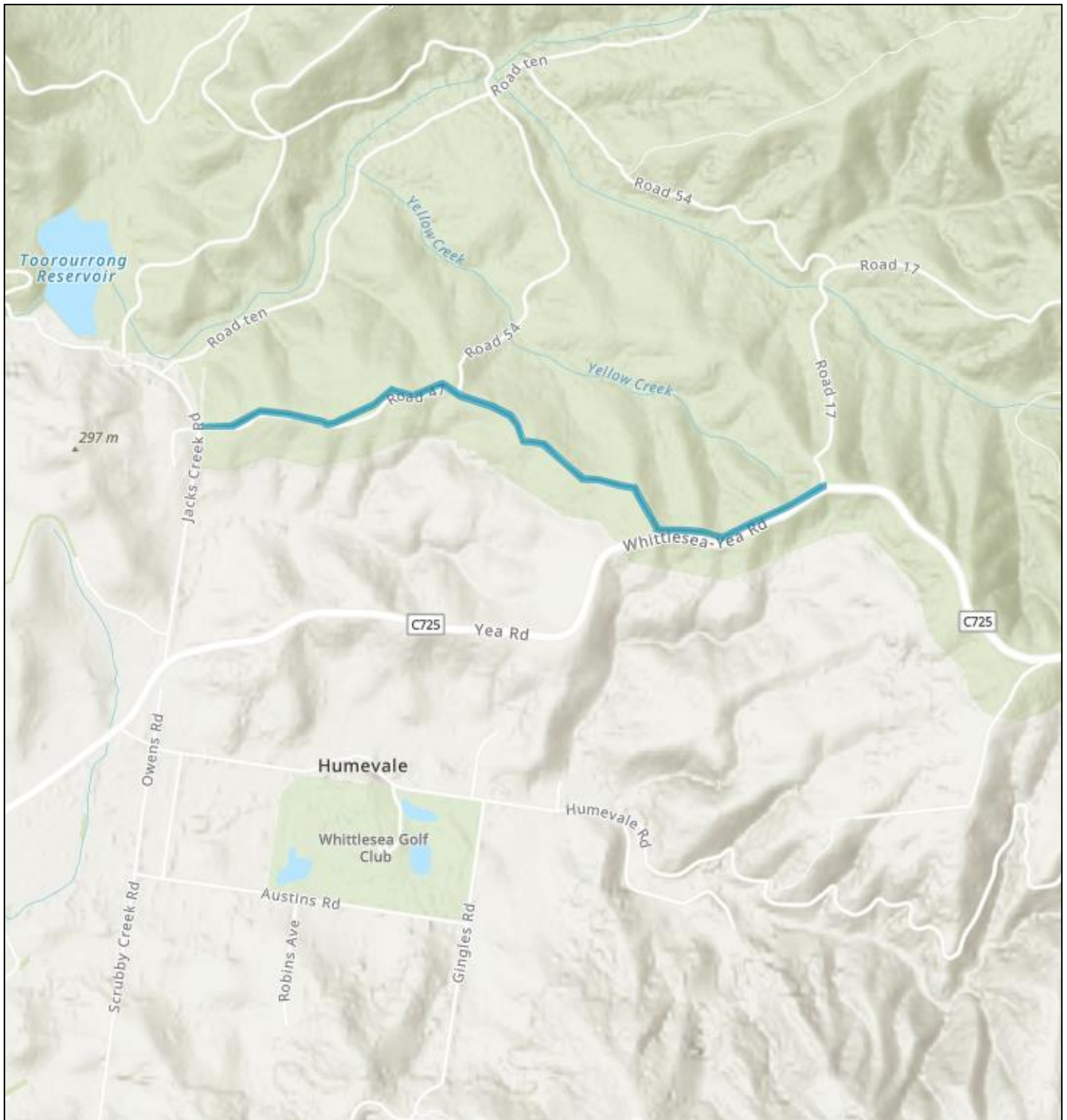
Impact: **No park access or tracks are impacted by these works.** Park users at Toorourrong Reservoir Park may see and hear machinery and crews.


Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: These works are to improve the fuel break to facilitate access and safety for firefighting, planned burning and our annual fuel break grass slashing program.
