**Date:** End January 2023

**Duration:** Approximately 3 weeks (weekdays only)

**Location:** Boundary East Track (see map)

Impact: Work crews and heavy machinery will be working in this area, so

there will be restricted access during works. You should avoid this

area if possible, but if you must use the track, follow the

instructions of the crew working on site.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been

undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

**Why:** These works are improving fuel break access and safety for

firefighting, emergencies and our annual fuel break grass


slashing program.
