

## FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Hazardous tree removal will take place in Dandenong Ranges
National Park in Montrose and Mount Evelyn in preparation for
spring planned burning.

**Date:** Early September 2021

**Duration:** Approximately five weeks (weekdays only).

**Location:** Far north area of Dandenong Ranges National Park bounded by

Moore Avenue, Mountain Crescent, and Wombalano Road (see

map next page).

Impact: Moore Avenue, Mountain Crescent, and Wombalano Road will

have one lane closed during some parts of the works. There may

be short delays to road users.

No park access or tracks are impacted by these works.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been

undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

**Why:** This work supports the safe delivery of three planned burns

proposed for spring 2021 – St Marks, Browns Track and the

western portion of Wilkilla Road. Visit www.ffm.vic.gov.au/jfmp to

These blocks sits within a bushfire Asset Protection Zone (APZ) and

Bushfire Moderation Zone (BMZ). These areas are managed

regularly using planned burning and mechanical means to reduce

bushfire risk to the surrounding communities.
