

FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Hazardous tree removal will take place in Dandenong Ranges National Park in Olinda in preparation for planned burning.

Date: Mid-September 2021 and prior to planned burn delivery.

Duration: Approximately 5 days (weekdays only).

Location: Eastern section of Dandenong Ranges National Park, on the

southern side Olinda Creek Road.

Impact: Olinda Creek Road will have traffic management in place during

the works. There may be short delays to road users.

No park access or tracks are impacted by these works.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been

undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: This work supports the safe delivery of a planned burn

proposed for autumn 2021– Olinda VW Track. Visit

This block sits within a Bushfire Moderation Zone (BMZ). This area

is managed using planned burning and mechanical means to
