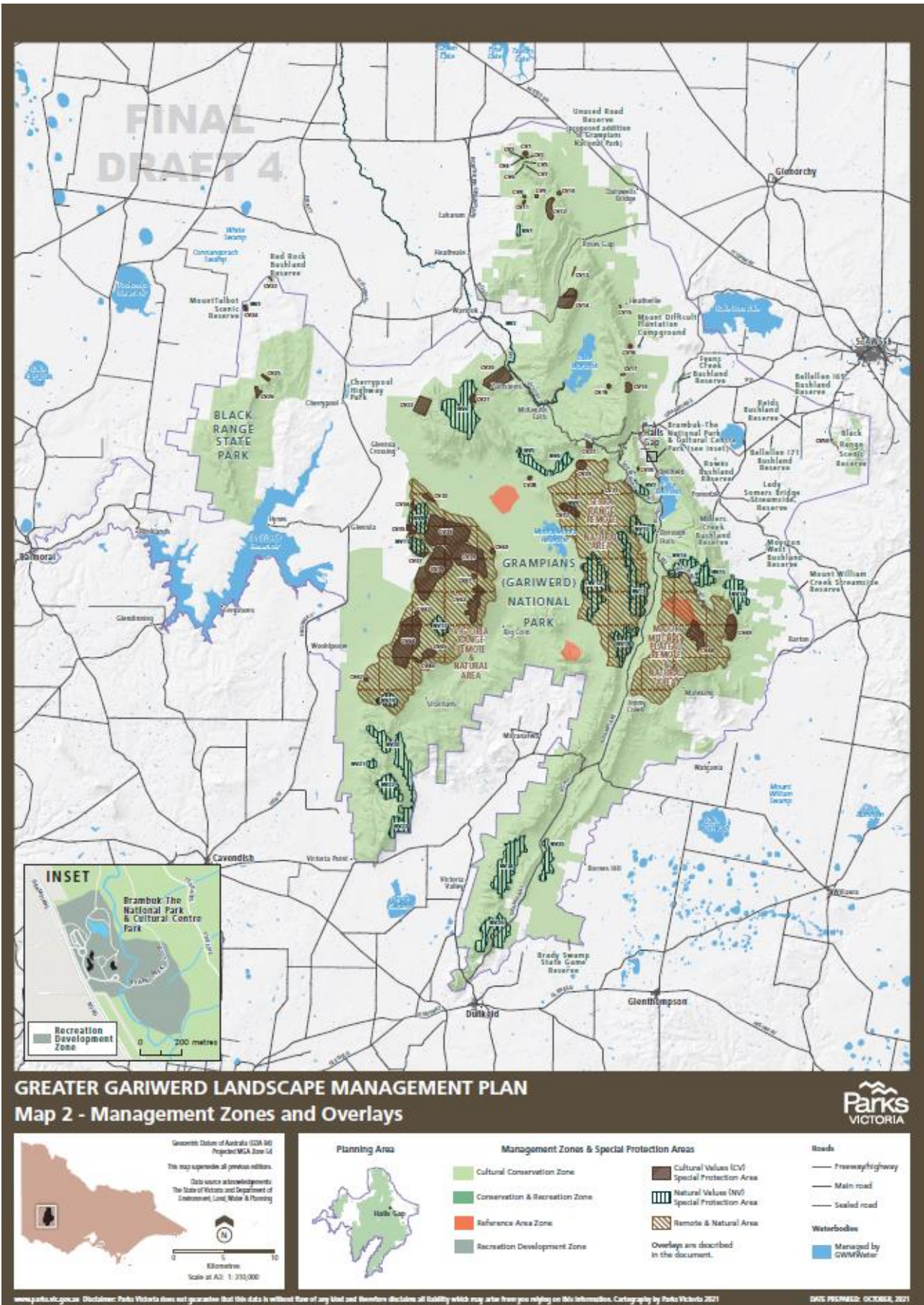

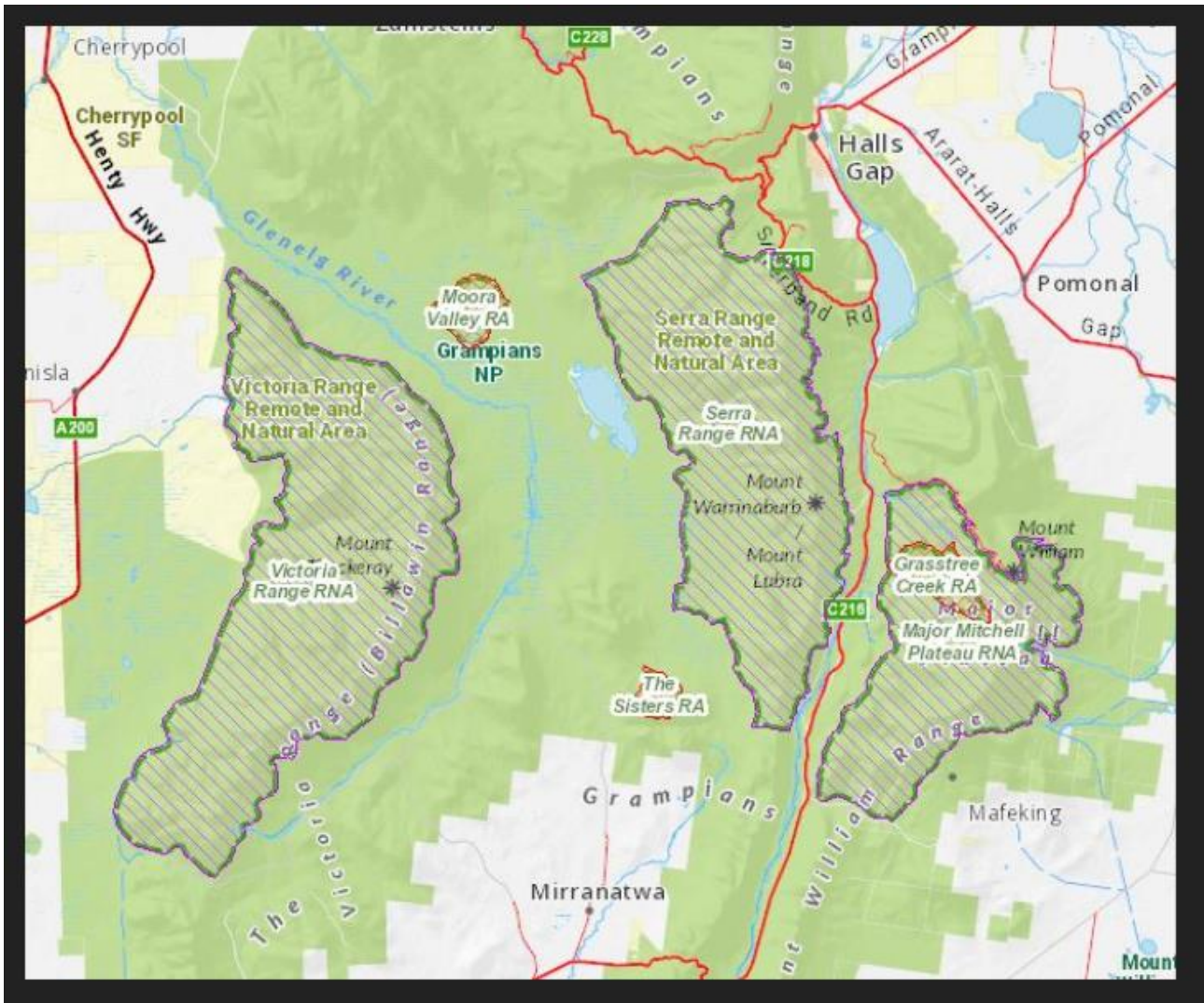

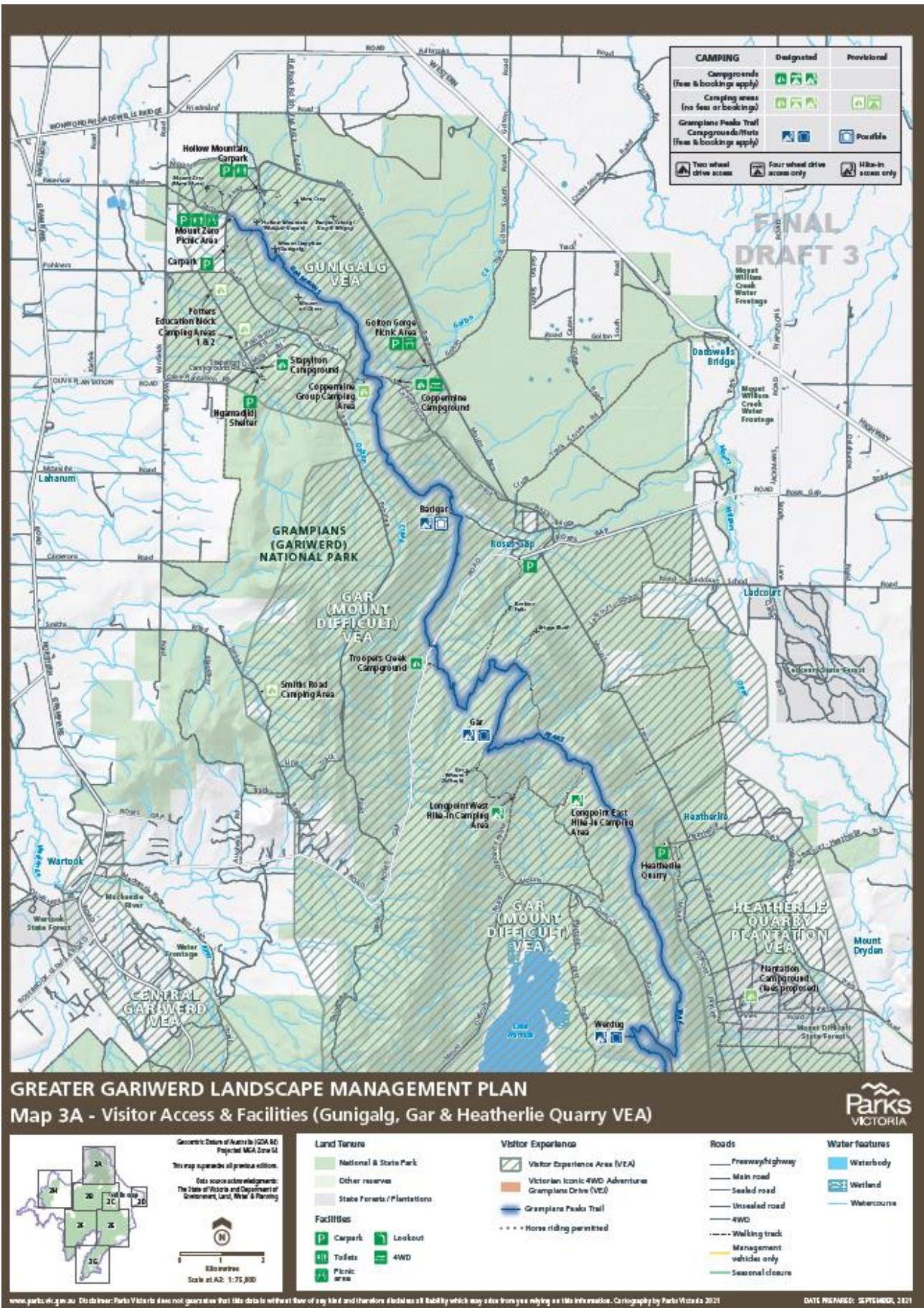

Highlight map showing named Reference Areas in Grampians National Park



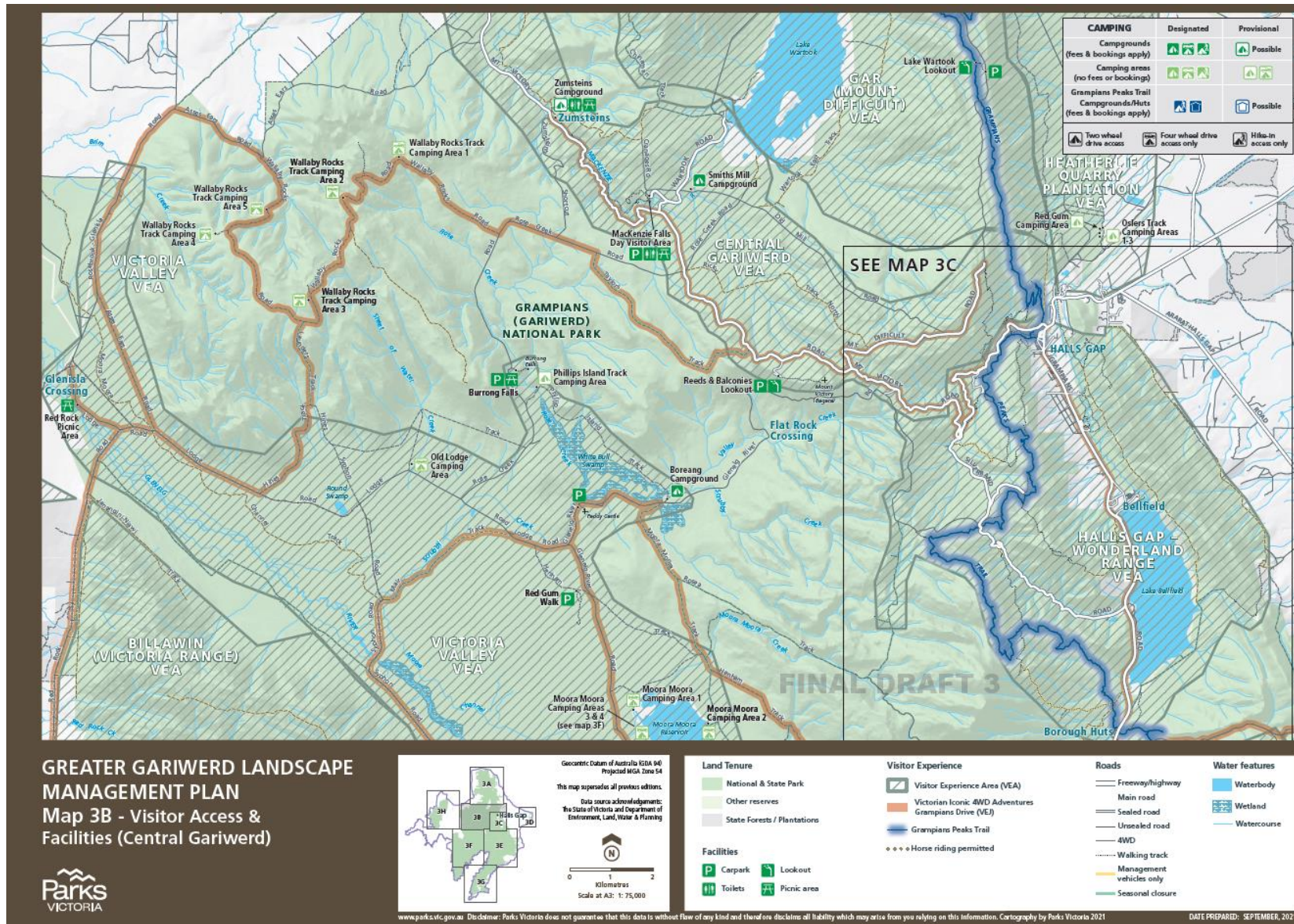

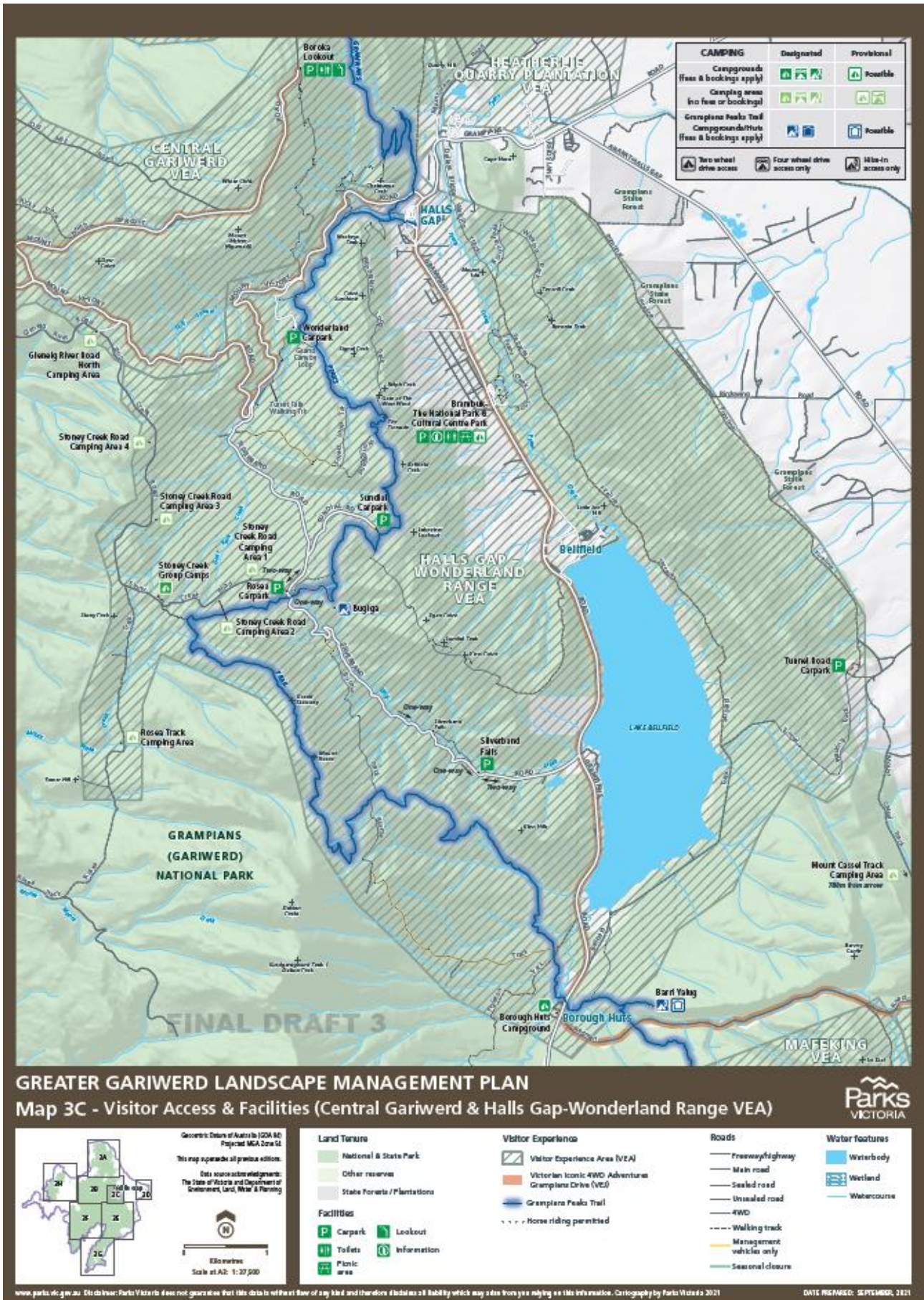

Map 3B Visitor Access & Facilities (Central Gariwerd VEA)

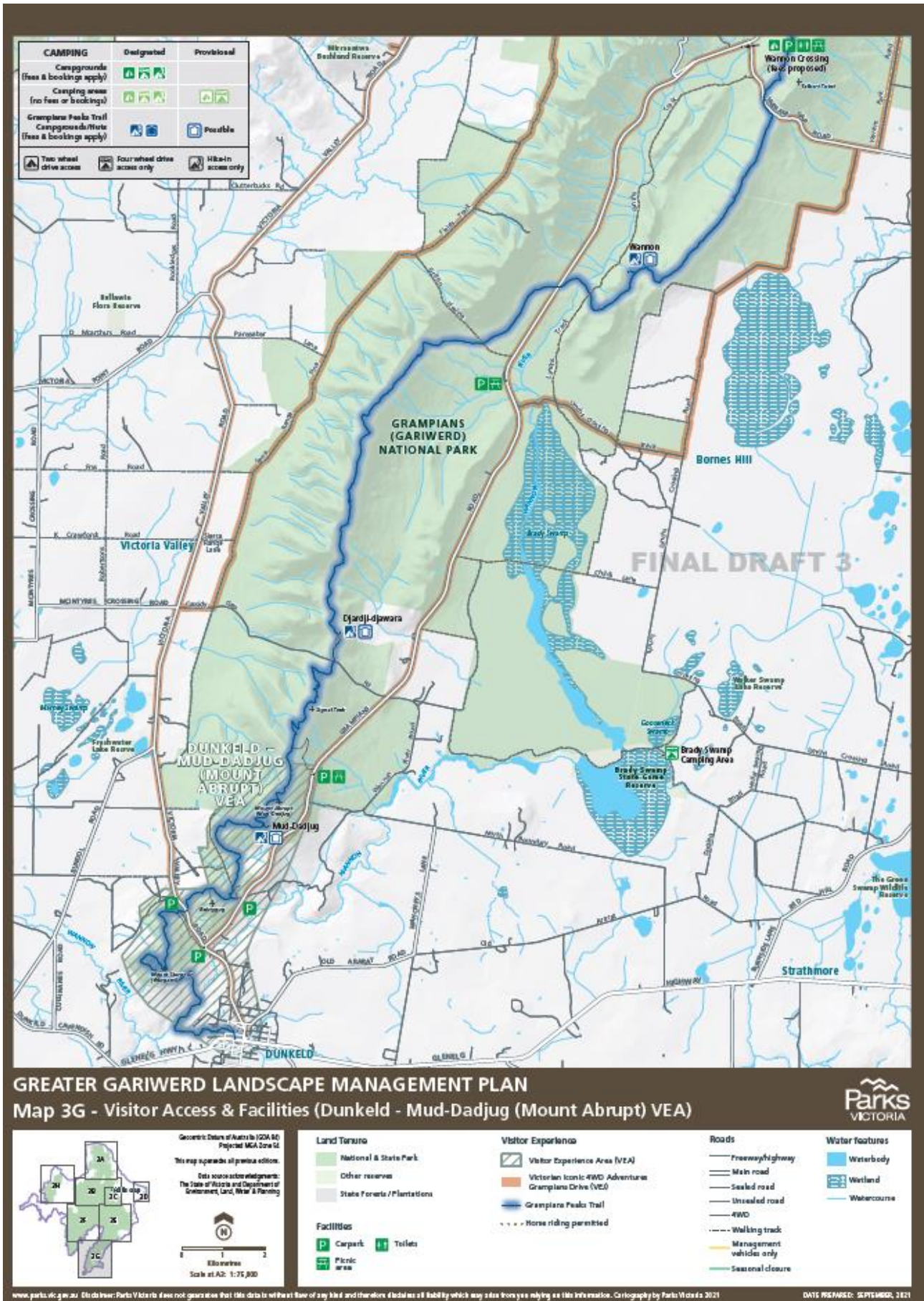

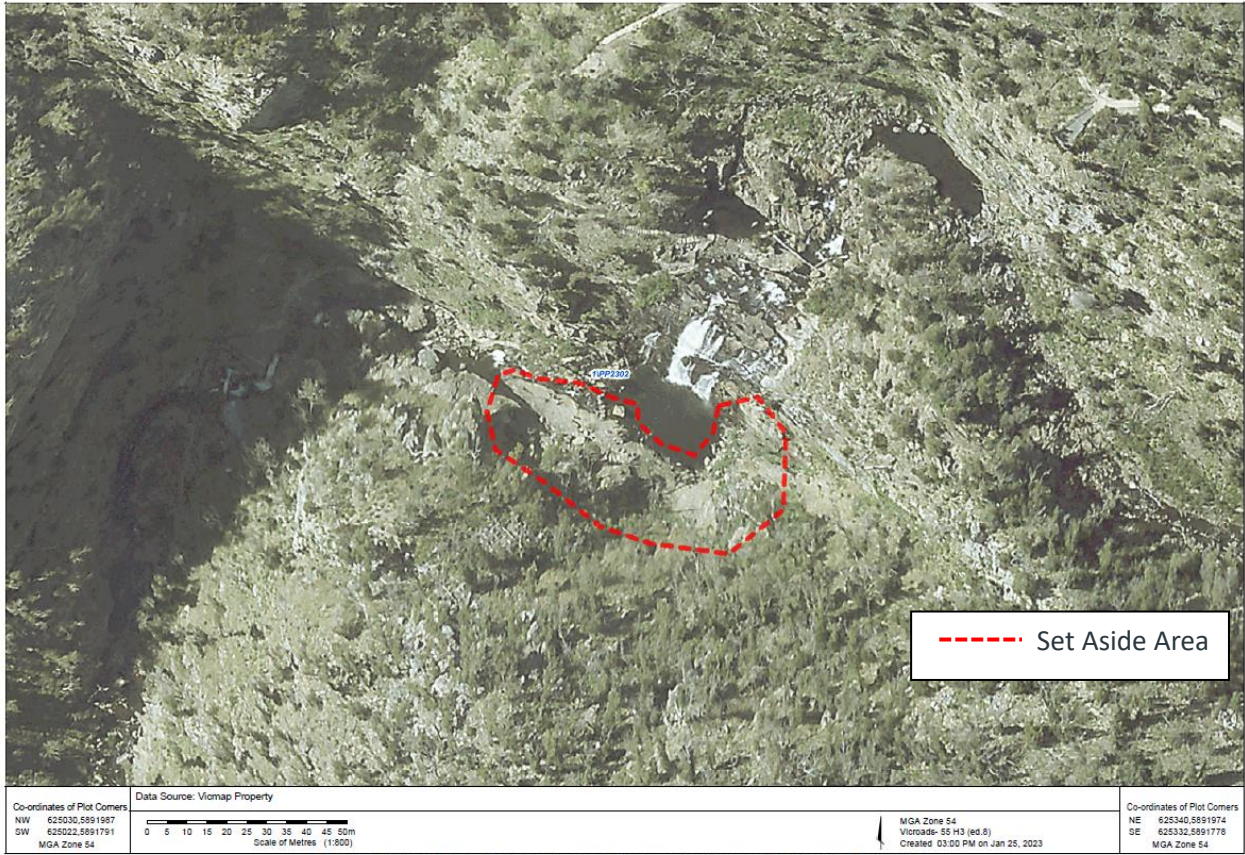

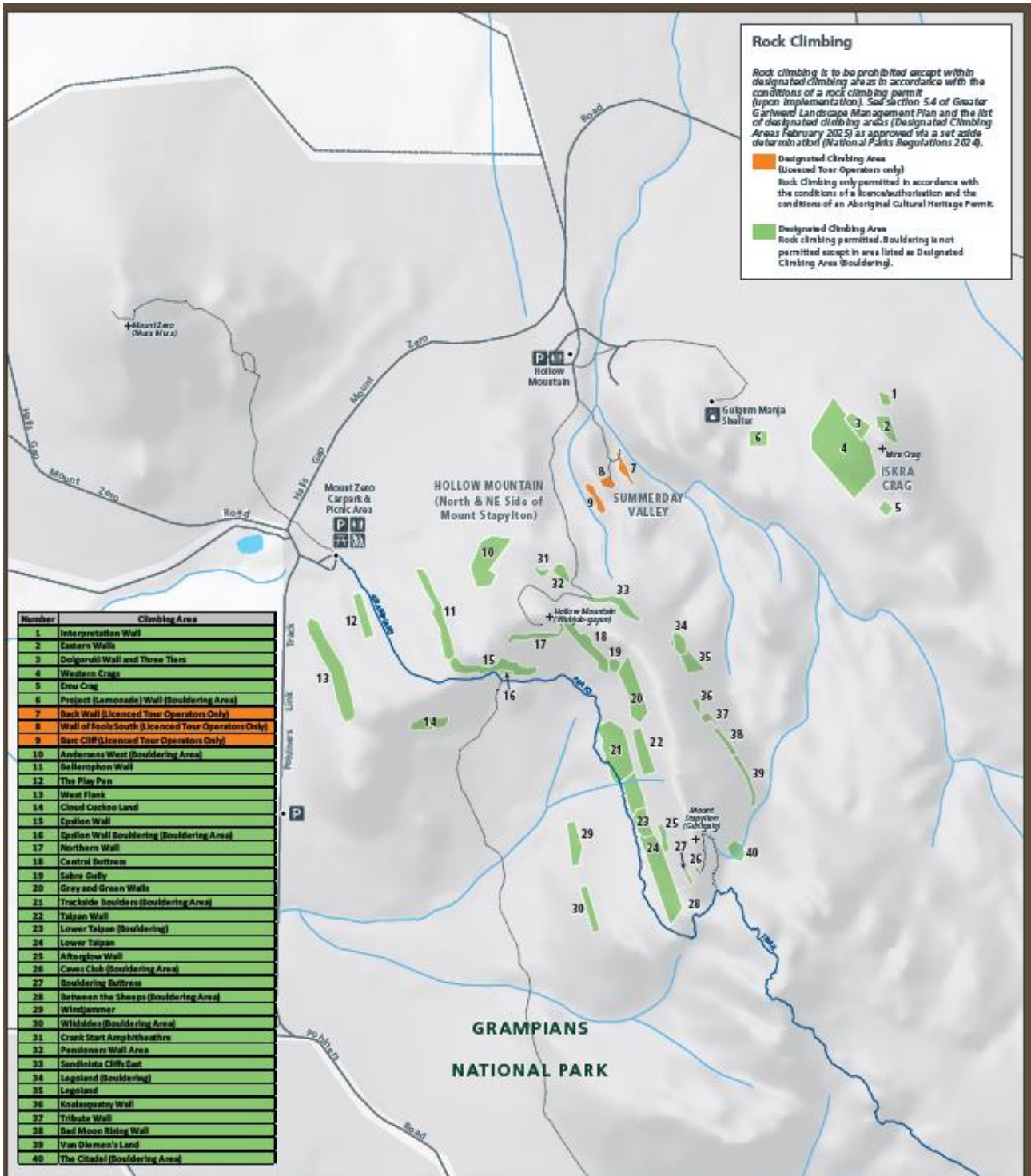
