Tips for camping in nature

This park is part of an Aboriginal cultural landscape. Parks Victoria respects the deep and continuing connection that Traditional Owners have to these lands and waters, and we recognise their ongoing role in caring for Country.



Put out your campfire completely with water अपनी कैम्पफ़ायर को पानी से पूरी तरह से बुझा दे।

Why? 10% of bushfires are caused by campfires

- Only light campfires in fireplaces provided by Parks Victoria.
- At least one person must stay by the campfire at all times.
- Use water to put out your campfire, not soil.
 If the ashes are cold, then it is safe to leave.
- Total Fire Ban = NO fires.





Do not wash your dishes in waterways (Rivers, streams, lakes, etc.) जलमार्गो (नदियों, झरर्नो, झीलों, आदि) में अपने बर्ततन न धोएं ।

Why? Soaps can harm plants and animals that also use the water



- Do not use soaps in or near waterways.
- Collect water with a bucket to wash dishes.
- Throw away dirty water at least 20m from waterways.



Do not collect wood for campfires in the park पार्क में कैम्पफाायर जलाने के लिए लकड़ी एकत्र न करें।

Why? Many animals live in logs and trees

- Do not cut down trees.
- Do not pick up logs or branches on the ground for campfires.
- Bring firewood from home OR buy firewood from a nearby town.





Use toilets that are available in the park पार्क में उपलब्ध शौचालर्यो का उपयोग करें।





Keep the parks clean and quiet पार्को को साफ और शांत रखें।

Why? Help keep our parks healthy and beautiful

- Do not leave rubbish in the park. Take it with you when you leave.
- Do not throw rubbish into campfires or toilets.
- Respect other campers by keeping noise low in the campgrounds.
- No noise after 11pm.
