Rock Climbing

Rock climbing is to be prohibited except within designated climbing areas in accordance with the conditions of a rock climbing permit (upon implementation). See section 5.4 of Greater Gariwerd Landscape Management Plan and the list of designated climbing areas (Designated Climbing Areas April 2026) as approved via a set aside determination (National Parks Regulations 2024).

Designated Climbing Area (Licenced Tour Operators only)
Rock Climbing only permitted in accordance with the conditions of a licence/authorisation and the conditions of an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Permit.

Designated Climbing Area
Rock climbing permitted. Bouldering is not permitted except in area listed as Designated Climbing Area (Bouldering).
