



Application to Change Vessel Nominated on Permit

In order to make an application for a change to the vessel nominated on an existing Berth / Mooring Permit, the two pages of this Application Form must be completed and returned to Parks Victoria.

The Application must be accompanied by proof of ownership documentation in the form of vessel registration papers. Should the vessel be unregistered, insurance documentation or a statutory declaration will be required as proof of ownership.

Permit Holders are strongly advised to consult with an Authorised Mooring Contractor before purchasing the new vessel to ensure it is suitable for the site. A maximum vessel length of 15 metres applies.
