**St Kilda Marina Entrance Channel Temporary Starboard Lateral Buoy Installed**

**Details:** Mariners are advised that a temporary lit Starboard Lateral Buoy, with characteristics LFI.G, has been installed at St Kilda Marina entrance channel. The buoy has been installed at approximate location 37° 52.299'S, 144° 58.406'E (WGS84), and shows best water around a shallowed section of the channel.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of St Kilda Marina entrance channel, and to check local tides and conditions before entry or departure.**
