**Date:** **Monday 26 January 2026 between 0700hrs and 1400hrs**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of the Mount Martha Australia Day (MMAD) Swim Event at Mount Martha Life Saving Club during the times nominated above.

A set aside will exist around the competition area, which is bounded by the shore and the following approximate locations (WGS84):

1. 38°15.931'S, 145°00.627'E
2. 38°15.764'S, 145°00.660'E
3. 38°15.729'S, 145°00.818'E

The competition area will be delineated by marker buoys and patrolled by event marshals.

**Relevant Law:** The set aside has been established under the *Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2025*. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event participants and Parks Victoria officers.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the event.**
