**Dredging for Beach Renourishment Works**

**Date: Immediate**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of dredging works for beach renourishment undertaken by the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) at Tootgarook, at approximate location (WGS84): 38°21.900'S, 144°51.000'E.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge operating in an area approximately offshore from Tootgarook Beach. Dredged material will be transported via pipeline and deposited on Tootgarook Beach.

The Pipeline, On-water plant, equipment, and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.**
