Kananook Creek Mouth - Maintenance Dredging Works

Date: **Tuesday 1 June 2021 until Friday 4 June 2021,
weather permitting.**

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works to be undertaken by Frankston City Council in the vicinity of Kananook Creek entrance, at approximate location 38°08.739'S, 145°06.965'E (WGS84).

Dredging works will be carried out with a long reach excavator. Dredged material will be deposited for beach renourishment to the north of Kananook creek with the use of a moxy truck.

Plant and equipment will be stored ashore during the works.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution and within the designated speed limit in the vicinity of the works.
