**Kananook Creek Mouth - Maintenance Dredging Works**

**Date:** Immediate until Friday 3 May 2024, weather permitting.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works to be undertaken by Frankston City Council in the vicinity of Kananook Creek entrance, at approximate location 38°08.739'S, 145°06.965'E (WGS84).

Dredging works will be undertaken via long reach excavator. Dredged material will be deposited for beach renourishment at the adjacent Frankston beach.

Plant and equipment will be stored ashore during the works.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works, and to observe signage and instruction from the excavator operator.**
