The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Martha Cove – Entrance Channel Dive Works**

**Date: Monday 13 July until Tuesday 14 July between 0730hrs and 1500hrs.**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of dive works occurring within the Martha Cove entrance channel at approximate location 38°18.386'S, 144°59.680'E (WGS84).

The works will take place within the overpass section of the channel, using divers and a support vessel.

When divers are operating, a white and blue flag (Alpha) will be displayed in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of Martha Cove.**
