**Details:** Mariners are advised of a change of conditions in the vicinity of Black Rock

Jetty, at approximate location (WGS84), 37°58.103'S, 145°00.578'E.

Shallow water and submerged rocks are present in the area to the North of

Black Rock Jetty.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of Black Rock Jetty and Half Moon Bay and transit through the channel marked with Port and Starboard lateral mark piles when navigating the

area.
