The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Werribee River Entrance – Maintenance Dredging

Date: Immediate

Previous Notices: 202(T) – 2023 is referred.

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging operations occurring at the entrance to Werribee River at approximate location 37°58.400'S, 144°41.210'E (WGS84). Works will also include the removal of sand from around Werribee South Jetty. Boat ramp facilities should not be affected during this time.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge and excavator. Dredged material will be deposited on the beach, north east of the River entrance.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are reminded to navigate within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the dredging works.
