

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

San Remo

San Remo Jetty - Maintenance Dredging

Date: Immediate

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works around the inner floating jetty at San Remo at approximate location 38°31.209'S, 145°21.912'E (WGS84).

Access to the jetty will be restricted during dredging operations.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge and are expected to take 4 to 8 days. Dredged material will be deposited on the beach, south of Davis Point.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the dredging works and be aware that the dredge is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre, and there may be floating or submerged objects such as pipelines.
