Boat Ramp Closure for Maintenance Dredging Works

Date: Immediate

Previous Notice: 162(T)-21 is referred

Details: Mariners are advised that the Queenscliff Boat Ramp at approximate location 38°15.788'S, 144°39.839'E (WGS84) has been closed for maintenance dredging works undertaken by Better Boating Victoria.

Dredging works will be carried out with the use of a cutter suction dredge, with dredged material deposited on Swan Island eastern beach.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.
