North-East Port Phillip Diving Inspections - Starboard Lateral Marks

Date: 23 June 2024

Details:

Mariners are advised that divers will be conducting pile inspection works on the Starboard Lateral Marks at the entrance to each of the listed harbours in positions (WGS84):

- 1. St Kilda Starboard Lateral Mark 37° 56.48'S, 144° 59.56'E
- 2. Middle Brighton Starboard Lateral Mark 37° 54.30'S, 144° 58.80'E
- 3. Sandringham Starboard Lateral Mark 37° 56' 29.00"S, 144° 59' 33.40'E

The works will take place using divers and support vessels.

When divers are operating, a white and blue flag (Alpha) will be displayed in accordance with the international standards.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when the works are being undertaken and at a speed of 5 knots or less within 100m of a dive flag.
