1. St Kilda Starboard Lateral Mark – 37° 56.48'S, 144° 59.56'E

2. Middle Brighton Starboard Lateral Mark – 37° 54.30'S, 144° 58.80'E

3. Sandringham Starboard Lateral Mark –  $37^{\circ}$  56' 29.00"S, 144° 59' 33.40'E

The works will take place using divers and support vessels.

When divers are operating, a white and blue flag (Alpha) will be displayed in

accordance with the international standards.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the

works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when the works are being undertaken and at a speed of 5 knots or less within 100m of a dive flag.
