The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Queenscliff Ferry Terminal - Fireworks Display

Date: **Saturday 20 June 2026, between 1945 hrs and 2200 hrs.**

Details: Mariners are advised of a Fireworks Display at Queenscliff between the times noted above.

A 360° set aside area for the fireworks display extends in a 280 m radius from a vessel located 0.2nm south of the Queenscliff Ferry Terminal at approximately 38°16.083'S, 144°40.483'E (WGS84), shown in the map below.

This set aside area is put in place to ensure public safety in the local port as per Work Safe requirements, delineating the safety fallout areas for this fireworks display.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the set aside area during the date and times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the declared set aside area.

Relevant Law: The set aside has been established under the Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2025. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event organisers and Parks Victoria officers.
