The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Black Rock
Half Moon Bay - Filming and helicopter event

Date: **Monday 05 August 2024 between 1230hrs and 1800hrs.**

Details: Mariners are advised of the 'Eve of Destruction' Filming occurring between the times nominated above.

Filming will occur from land, with a helicopter flying offshore between Black Rock and Half Moon Bay (100m out, minimum 25 metres from water level).

A set aside area has been established and will be defined by two marker buoys and patrolled by event marshals at the following approximate locations:

- 37°58.1717'S, 145°0.505'E
- 37°58.26'S, 145°0.5367'E

The set aside prohibits all persons entering the area between times and dates as outlined. The full declaration including event information is available on Parks Victoria's website.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the filming area and observe signage and directions from filming officials.

Relevant Law The set aside has been established under the Port Management (local Ports) regulations 2015, Regulation 11(1).
