Queenscliff Queenscliff Harbour Destination Mooring Submerged Working Buoy

Date:ImmediateDetails:Mariners are advised that a destination mooring, located within Queenscliff
Harbour at approximate location 38°15.704'S, 144°39.987'E (WGS84), is
temporarily unavailable and has a submerged working buoy attached.The temporary working buoy is submerged at approximately 2 metres below
the surface and could cause a hazard to navigation for vessels with a deep
draft.The destination mooring and mooring buoy will be reinstated as soon as
practicable.Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the
Destination Mooring.
